

INTRODUCTION – Incidence of fibroids during pregnancy is 2%. Complications increase by 2-4 fold as number and size of fibroid increase(Williams Obstetrics 25 th edition)

METHOD – Single Centre retrospective study
Data retrieved from electronically maintained case films
Study period 2020-2023
Total no of pregnant women - 455
Total no of pregnancies with large and medium size fibroids -14
Incidence – 3 %

CONCLUSION – Continuation of pregnancy is a viable option with good ante, intra and postpartum care with minimum complications

RESULTS – Of 14 pregnancies with medium and large sized fibroids , 12 delivered at term (98 %) , 2 delivered preterm (2 %)
12 delivered by LSCS (98 %), 2 delivered vaginally (2 %)
